Parish Church of England Primary School is a 3-form entry school, which is thought to be the oldest educational establishment in the London Borough of Bromley, dating back to a 1716 Charity Foundation.

In September 1986, the school transferred, along with the pupils and staff of St Mary's Church of England Primary School, to its current location - a renovated eighteenth century mansion known as Plaistow Lodge.



This is a listed building, which stands in its own grounds in London Lane. This along with a suite of 12 classrooms, a separate reception block, a gym, our field and our Forest School enables us to provide a unique, exciting and fulfilling education for our pupils.

We are part of the Aquinas Multi Academy Trust, a group of schools (2 secondary and 9 primary) that share similar educational visions and values.

As a church school we work in close liaison with Bromley Parish Church and St Mary's Church. We endeavour to teach our children about the Christian faith through our Acts of Collective Worship and through the way we live and work together.
